The World Council of Churches has condemned the terrorist attacks on the Coptic Christians in Alexandria and Tanta where at least 45 people were killed in bomb attacks. Part of the message from the church in Egypt reads -

“As an Easter people, we will not give in to terrorism and those who wish the Church harm; we will continue to engage with society, ever seeking its good: and we will live out Christ's message of peace and love and justice”. We, as Christians are encouraged to keep the Egyptian Church in our prayers.
