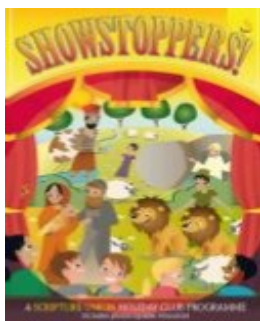


SHOWSTOPPERS!
