**Moderator designate of the Church of Scotland for 2017/2018**

The Rev Dr Derek Browning has been appointed Moderator designate of the Church of Scotland for 2017/2018. Dr Browning, who graduated with the degree of Doctor of Ministry at Princeton Theological Seminary in the United States in 1997, will succeed the Right Rev. Dr Russell Barr as the Church of Scotland's ambassador at home and abroad. He read history at Corpus Christi College in Oxford, and opted to train for the ministry ahead of pursuing other graduate career options working for the BBC in London and the oil giant Shell. Dr Browning is also a graduate of St Mary's College in St Andrews, was ordained at Cupar Old Parish Church in Fife in 1987.
