UNICEF – Jars of Grace

For a great number of years now we have made this appeal from UNICEF our Christmas project. The intention behind it is that we all keep a jar in our kitchen and every time we have a meal we put a little something in the jar. Some people use it for all the spare change in their pockets. The jars are brought to church on our Christmas Gift day service and the money counted and sent to UNICEF to help provide meals and other forms of aid for those children, at home and abroad, who are not as fortunate as we are. The children love collecting these jars from the adults and bringing them forward to tip into the buckets. In the interests of safety if you have a plastic tub or jar rather than glass this would be very much appreciated. (Poundworld do a good plastic drinking mug which would be suitable and if you decide to use one of them please put your name on it and we will see that they are returned for next year).
